## DAY OF EVENT SCHEDULE:

Friday, March 13, 2015

**Parent drivers are to meet at Barry Hall  
@ 10AM for instruction & voucher pick-up.**

Teachers bring class to dismissal area in front of school. Drivers meet teacher there, receive student car assignments and permission slips. (departure times are K & 1 @ 10:20 • 2 & 3 @ 10:25 • 4 & 5 @ 10:30 • 6, 7 & 8 @ 10:35)

DRESS: Uniform shorts, walkathon t-shirt and comfortable shoes with socks.  
Students who do not have a walkathon shirt are to wear their regular uniform shirts.

LUNCH: Lunches will be pre-ordered and prepaid.  
A sack lunch must be brought if a boxed lunch was not ordered.  
(All lunches will be eaten at the park.)

WALK:

- Each class must stay together for the entire walk. • Juice will be supplied
- Must stay on the path at all times (important)
- Be considerate of other people who may be walking or enjoying the lakes
- Lunches will be passed out as each class returns from the walk.

REMEMBER:

- ✓ walk only (no running) -important! ✓ water bottles provided
- ✓ hat or visors for sun protection (may be worn during the walk and picnic only)
- ✓ sunscreen (no electronic devices - no cell phones - no littering please!)

We invite parents to enjoy the afternoon at the lake after lunch.  
Bring blankets and chairs if you wish for lunch. Picnic tables are also available.

**Important!**

**Drivers that are car-pooling (must have 3 Academy students)  
will receive parking fee vouchers at the 10am drivers meeting in Barry Hall  
A separate drivers sign up sheet is required for preschool children.**

**All other drivers must pay \$3.00 at the lake entrance.**

### Walkathon Guidelines for Parent Drivers/Supervisors

- ✓ Important: the group of students a driver is assigned are your responsibility.
  - 1) to get students safely to and from the lake
  - 2) stay with the students during the walk
  - 3) return students safely back to school
- ✓ Classes need to be kept together during the walk and the supervisors need to make sure this happens.
- ✓ See above map of Santee Lakes for walking directions.
 

(Signs will be posted and volunteers will be available around the lakes for direction.)

Preschool walks around Lake 5 & returns to starting point  
 Kindergarten and 1st grade go around Lake 3 & returns to starting point  
 Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 goes up to Lake 2, goes around twice & returns to starting point  
 Grades 6, 7, 8 goes up to Lake 2, goes around twice then walks to the fence on the top of Lake 1 & returns to starting point
- ✓ Lunches will be distributed when each class has returned to the park.
 

(Don't let students race ahead or lag behind.)
- ✓ Do not hesitate to remind students about:
  - no running
  - no littering
  - being considerate/polite to those who are also using the path, etc.
- ✓ When returning to school, students need to be walked back to their respective classroom.
 

If the teacher has not yet returned, keep the students together outside the classroom.  
(no playing on equipment, etc.)
- ✓ ALL students need to return to classrooms for roll call. Popsicles will be distributed by classroom.
 

(Dismissal is from 2:15- 2:30 from the classrooms.) Day care will be available at 2:30.
